The Reverend Dr. Jeremy Begbie will examine how music has unique powers to reach into the depths and heights of the Gospel. Friday evening will feature an event with Dean Timothy Kimbrough and Jeremy Begbie and piano. Saturday will feature two lectures (including piano performance and recorded music) titled "Re-Shaping Lament: Music and the Psalms of Sorrow" and "Joy in the Morning: The Music of Resurrection."

The Reverend Dr. Begbie is the inaugural holder of the Thomas A. Langford Research Professorship in Theology at Duke University Divinity School. He is also a Senior Member at Wolfson College, Cambridge and Affiliated Lecturer in the Faculty of Music at the University of Cambridge.
