EDUCATION FOR MINISTRY (EfM):

EfM is a Christian education and formation program developed by the School of Theology at Sewanee. EfM covers the basics of a theological education in the Old and New Testaments, church history, liturgy, and theology with emphasis on theological reflection. Students enroll for one year at a time and complete the course in four years. More information is available on the EfM website, Sewanee.edu/EfM. The cost is \$350/year. Partial scholarships may be available. Groups meet on Tuesday evenings or Wednesday mornings and each has room for a limited number of new students.
