CATECHESIS TEACHER TRAINING LEVEL I



Two courses will be offered for Level I Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Level I covers the presentations that are offered to 3-6 year olds. The lessons have been used over the past 50 years to encourage the faith life of young children through

prayer, liturgy and the Bible. A typical training lasts for 90 hours and Christ Church will offer two different paths towards accomplishing this.

Summer/Winter training (Part 1 was offered last summer; new class members are welcome): Monday, August 19, through Thursday, August 22 (Part 2) and Monday, January 13, and Thursday, January 16, 2014 (Part 3).

Fall training: Begins Tuesday, October 1, and continues on October 8, 15, 22, 29; November 5, 12, 19; January 21, 28, February 4, 11, 18, 25; March 4, 11, and concludes on March 25, 2014.

These classes meet from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Childcare and lunch is provided for all classes. Classes will all meet at the Cathedral. There is a nominal charge for lunch and a \$35 registration fee for Christ Church parishioners.
