

Vestry Minutes of Christ Church  
1829

June 29<sup>th</sup> 1829

At a Meeting of the Vestry of Christ Church Nashville - present Claiborne, Fogg, Shelby, Stewart, and Baldwin, Jr. - Henry Baldwin was elected Secretary of the Vestry.

1<sup>st</sup> Where on motion it was resolved that the Vestry proceed to the election of delegates to attend the Episcopal Convention to be held in Nashville on the first of July and to the election of Wardens.

Where Mr. George Weller, Mr. Thos. Claiborne, and Mr. F.B. Fogg were duly elected delegates to attend the convention and Mr. Jas. Stewart and Mr. Thomas Claiborne were duly elected Wardens.

2<sup>nd</sup> On motion of Mr. Stewart it was Resolved that the Secy be authorized to purchase a blank book in which to keep the record of the proceedings of the Vestry --- adjourned

At a meeting of the Vestry, present Messrs. Claiborne, Fogg, Shelby, Stewart, and Baldwin, Jr., it was

3<sup>d</sup> Resolved that the Vestry will purchase a lot of ground for the purpose of erecting there on a Church edifice and that they will purchase of Mr. Jas. Stewart sixty feet front on Church on Ewing Street running back eighty feet on High Street the corner of Mr Stewart's lot for the sum of twenty-four hundred dollars, one thousand to be paid in eight months and the

balance in two annual payments with interest from the first of January next.

4<sup>th</sup> Resolved that Messrs. Claiborne, Shelby, and Stewart be a building committee and that they are authorized to receive proposals for and [illeg.] the erection of the church edifice on the above lot
