

Vestry Minutes of Christ Church
1835

April 20th 1835

At a meeting of the congregation of Christ Church held on Easter Monday the 20th April 1835, Rev. G. Weller in the chair, G.M. Fogg, Secretary. The following persons were duly elected vestrymen for the ensuing year viz. Messrs. F.B. Fogg, Shelby, M. Watson, G.M. Fogg, D. Craighead, E.D. Hicks, and A.H. Litton.

On motion resolved that the Rector with Messrs. Shelby, F.B. Fogg, and H.L. Douglas be appointed a committee to take such steps as to them may seem expedient to presume order in the galleries and prevent the defacing of the church.

Ordered that the Rector be authorized to designate proper pews in the lower part of the church for the accommodation of young men from the college.

Ordered that Col. H.L. Douglas, Messrs. Watson and Hicks be appointed a committee to solicit subscriptions for the purpose of paying the debt of the church.
