

Vestry Minutes of Christ Church  
1836

July 25<sup>th</sup> 1836

At a meeting of the congregation of Christ Church, Rev G. Weller in the chair, held on Monday the 25<sup>th</sup> July 1836, it was resolved unanimously that the congregation proceed to the election of vestrymen to hold their office until the next regular election in consequence of there having been none chosen on Easter Monday last. After counting the ballots the following persons were declared to be duly elected by the President viz. John Shelby, M. Watson, E.D. Hicks, F.B. Fogg, James Diggons, and D. Williams. (Kemp L.)

At a meeting of the vestry held immediately after the election, present the Rector and Messrs. Watson, F.B. Fogg, Diggons, Williams, and G.M. Fogg

G.M. Fogg was duly elected Treasurer and Secretary for the ensuing year and Messrs. Shelby and Kemp church wardens.

A communication was then made by the Rector upon the subject of his salary after which he retired.

The vestry took the same into consideration and appointed Messrs. Watson, F.B., and G.M. Fogg a committee to consult upon the subject and report to a subsequent meeting of the vestry.
