On motion G. M. Poyy was duly elected Secretary & Treasurer.

On motion F. P. Poyy, G. M. Poyy & George Hunt were duly elected delegates to the next Diocesan Convention to be held at La Grange on the last Wednesday in May 1858.

The following resolution was unanimously adopted.

Resolved: That it is a regulation of this vestry that all pew rents are to be paid semi annually in advance, therefore any persons occupying a pew in the church, being in arrears for rent for as much as one year rent or on failure to settle the same by cash or note when applied to, shall be notified by the Secy to vacate the pew forthwith.
