Meeting of Vestry and Council
March 14, 1938

Peace committee reported that the peace plan should be continued, that a survey should be made and only those who are interested be continued on the peace list. This report was passed by the vestry and council. Mr. Nellums was re-elected Chairman of the peace plan.

Moved and seconded that the mission at Old Hickory [illeg.] work among our young people be made the object of the peace plan. Motion carried.

Mr. Martin makes motion for consideration at next meeting that the Vestry and Council contribute \$1,000.00 from the Whiteford Cole bequest for the building fund for an Old Hickory Church on condition that the congregation at Old Hickory raise \$3,000.00.

On motion of Mr. W.C. Brown it was resolved that the committee of the Vestry and Council appointed at a previous meeting to look into the work at Old Hickory be instructed to confer with a committee of Old Hickory people and to bring in a report

concerning a proper place of worship and means of providing the same.
